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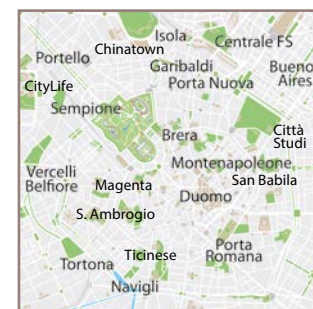

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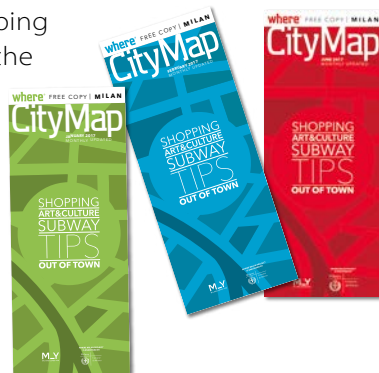

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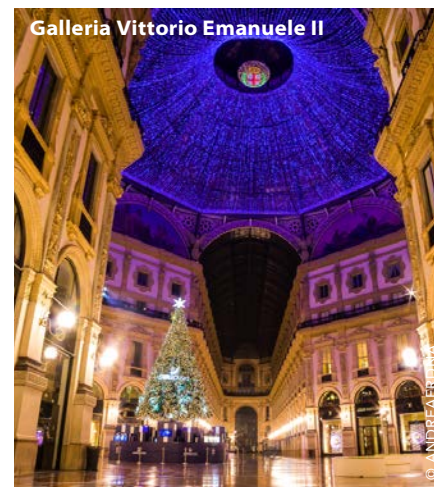

## LA SCALA GRAND OPENING

The opening of the opera season at the **Teatro alla Scala** is more than just a premiere; it is one of the year's most glamorous events, infused with history and tradition and attended by Milan's social and cultural elite. The star of this year's premiere is '**Andrea Chénier**', **Umberto Giordano**'s masterpiece, which debuted at La Scala in 1896. This opera tells the story of poet Chénier's life during the French Revolution and will be conducted by **Riccardo Chailly** and directed by **Mario Martone** (3 December-Preview for Young People, 7-Premiere, 10, 13, 16, 19, 22, December and 2, 5 January).

The performance will open the theatre's action-packed season with 15 operas, 7 ballets, 8 symphony concerts and 7 song recitals, plus special evening events, performances by international guests and children's concerts. THE VISIONARY MASTER OF UKIYO E

Bizarre worlds, visionary landscapes, beautiful women plus Kabuki actors, cats, carp, mythical animals, legendary heroes, Samurai warriors

and bandits. These are the key themes of the works by Utagawa Kuniyoshi (1797-1861), displayed together for the **first time** at an exhibition in Italy. 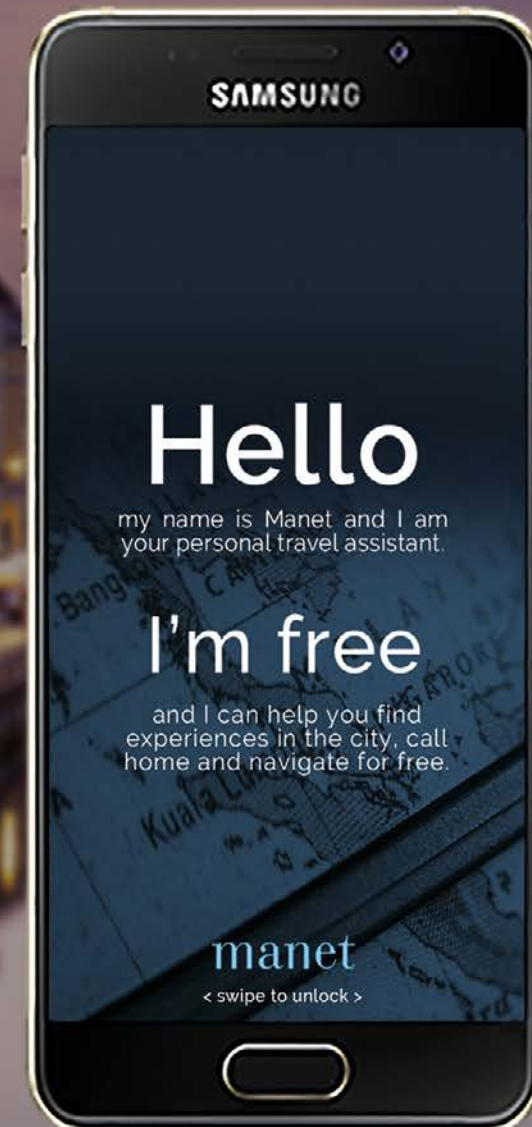

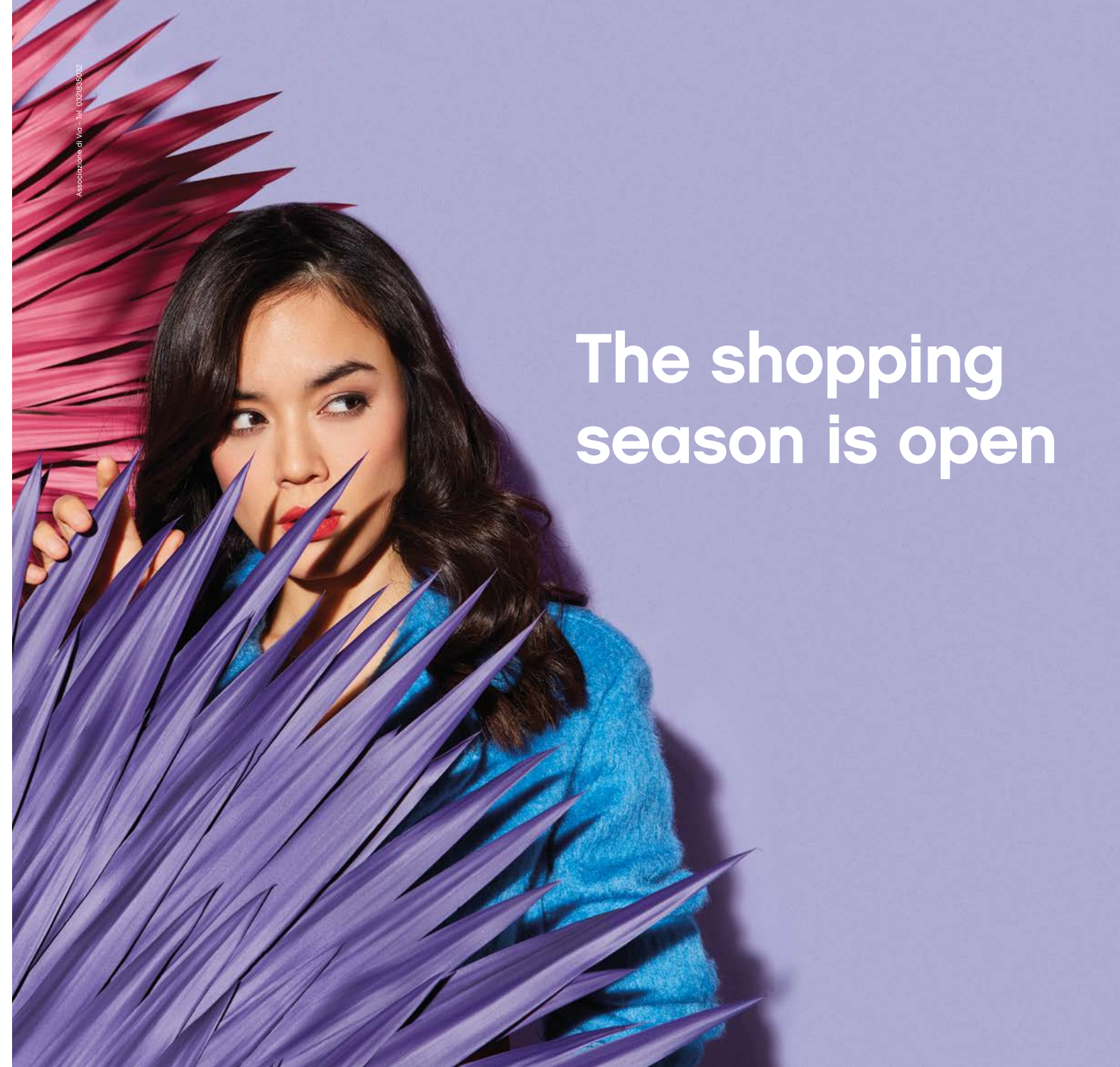

Located in the heart of the city, and known by the locals as the 'Living Room of the Milanese', the Galleria is considered the oldest shopping arcade in the world. ### Duomo

One of Milan's most well-trodden shopping routes starts at the Piazza del Duomo with the renowned department store Rinascente, offering wide range of fashion items under one roof, and continues onto Corso Vittorio Emanuele II, the pedestrian street lined with the most popular brand-name stores. **Map F4**

### Quadrilatero della Moda

### Brera

## Welcome back Caravaggio!

After a 10-year hiatus, Palazzo Reale is showcasing an innovative exhibition dedicated to the 17th-century maestro and his futuristic pictorial technique. By **Giulia Minero**

After the success of 'Caravaggio and Europe' in 2005, the exhibition that captivated the attention of art lovers from all over the world, Michelangelo Merisi, better known as **Caravaggio** and his works are back in Milan. A fabulous comeback, which sees the Baroque master playing a lead role at the spaces of Palazzo Reale, plus a wealth of interesting innovations. Featuring **20 works**, the exhibition 'Inside Caravaggio' stems from a groundbreaking project, curated by Rossella Vodret under the patronage of a scientific committee headed by Keith Christiansen. For the first time, the painter's masterpieces are gathered together and displayed alongside diagnostic analyses performed on the works to reveal the artist's creative process.

*What begins in the work of Caravaggio is, quite simply, modern painting.*

Thanks to the use of radiographic images and multi-media equipment, the public will have a chance to explore the different stages involved in the work process, from the first draft to the initial brushstrokes, plus any changes that were made during the course of the work, helping viewers to better understand the enormous artistic and historical relevance. They are on loan from the most prestigious Italian and foreign museums and collections, and include several of Caravaggio's best-known works such as 'Judith Beheading Holofernes', 'St. John the Baptist', 'Boy Bitten by a Lizard' and the 'Sacrifice of Isaac'.

Thanks to an in-depth analysis of each canvas, the exhibit offers the public a previously undiscovered journey into the **artist's stylistic evolution**, characterized by an increased naturalism in the depiction of subjects, more realistic settings and above all, his dramatic use of lighting effects, known as **chiaroscuro**. The masterpieces on exhibit are arranged in chronological order, and based on recent studies, are supported by selected documents from the **State Archives of Rome and Siena**, aimed at shedding light on Caravaggio's personal vicissitudes which, in less than 15 years of activity, were interwoven with the figurative development of the artist considered the father of modern painting.

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### GENOA AND THE AQUARIUM

Since time immemorial the charm of this city of sea and hills, a crossroads of different peoples and cultures, has attracted the attention of writers, poets and singers/songwriters who have described its beauty in their verses. The jewel in its crown is the **Aquarium**, the largest in Italy and the second largest in Europe after Valencia's aquarium in Spain. Covering a surface area of as many as 9,700 sq.m, the exhibition takes visitors in discovery of the Aquarium's 71 tanks housing an amazing array of fish and reptile species. Particularly worthy of note are its five large pools, viewable from both floors of the aquarium, housing dolphins, sharks, seals, manatees and turtles as well as countless other marine species. ### LAKES OF LOMBARDY

Each year the lakes of Lombardy attract millions of visitors thanks to their mild climate, breathtaking scenery, natural beauties and historic and artistic treasures. The shores of **Lake Maggiore** (90 km from Milan) wash up on the banks of Piedmont and Lombardy, while its northern basin lies in the mountainous region of Switzerland. The most famous island is Isola Bella, anchored like a fantastic ship-garden and dominated by the majestic **Palazzo Borromeo** ([www.isoleborromeo.it](http://www.isoleborromeo.it)). **Lake Como** must-visits include the Gothic Duomo,



the Romanesque basilicas of San Fedele and Sant'Abbondio, the neoclassical Villa Olmo and, in Cernobbio, the deluxe Villa d'Este and Villa Erba (75 km from Milan). Other fabulous lake destinations near Milan include **Lake Orta**, **Lake Varese** and **Lake Lugano**.

### VENICE

The major attractions of Venice (275 km from Milan), such as the awe-inspiring **Basilica of St. Mark**, the Bell Tower and Palazzo Ducale, are all situated just nearby **St. Mark's Square**. Just a few steps from the square, well worth a visit are the historic **Teatro della Fenice** and, burdened with legend, the Bridge of Sighs, one of Venice's most characteristic bridges together with the **Ponte Rialto**. In terms of uniqueness, Venice tops all other cities with its canals – which can be navigated aboard one of the city's famous gondolas – and **Murano**, **Torcello** and **Burano**, three charming, small islands rich in history.

### PAVIA

The city of Pavia enchants visitors with its age-old history, testimonies of which include the **Visconteo Castle**, a sumptuous, richly decorated historic residence surrounded by magnificent gardens, and the city's **Ponte Coperto** (Covered Bridge) spanning the Ticino river. The streets of its centre, including Corso Cavour, Corso Garibaldi and Corso Strada Nuova, are a haven for shoppers and gourmands alike who will be delighted by the area's chic boutiques, including iconic furrier Annabella, upscale restaurants and pastry shops. Just a short distance from the centre, on the road leading back to Milan, make sure to visit the 16th century Carthusian monastery of the **Certosa**, renowned for its architectural beauty and the opulence of its gardens ([www.certosadipavia.com](http://www.certosadipavia.com)). 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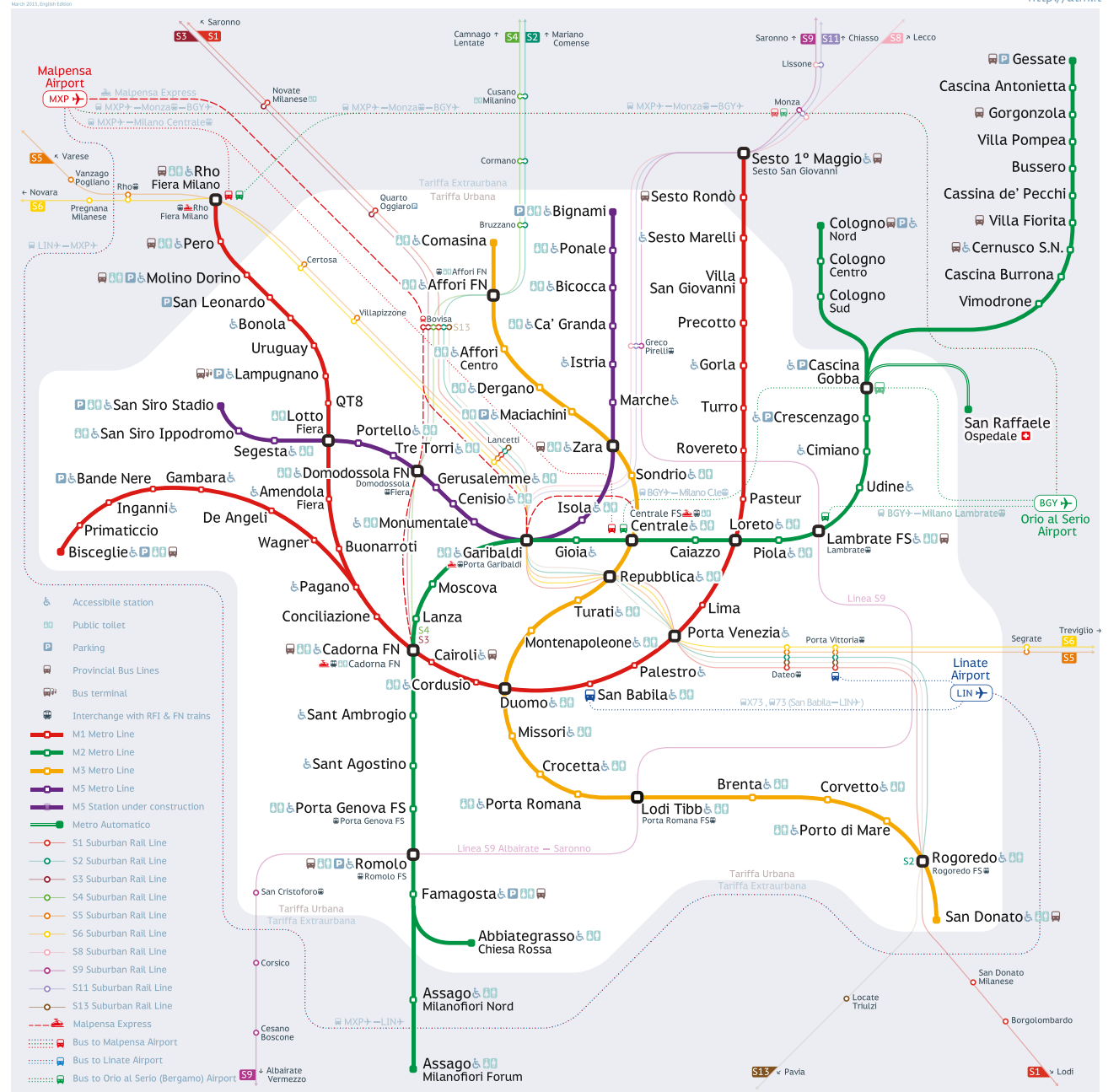

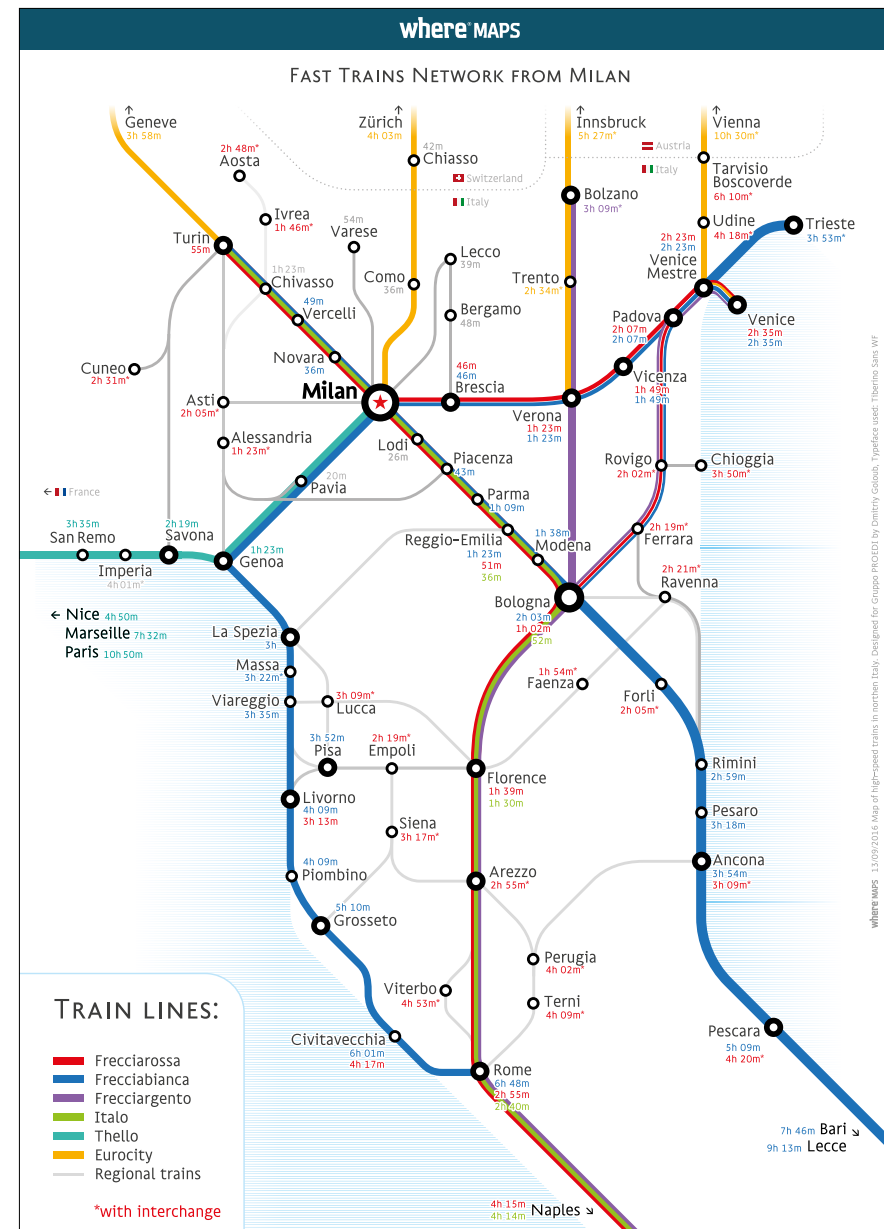

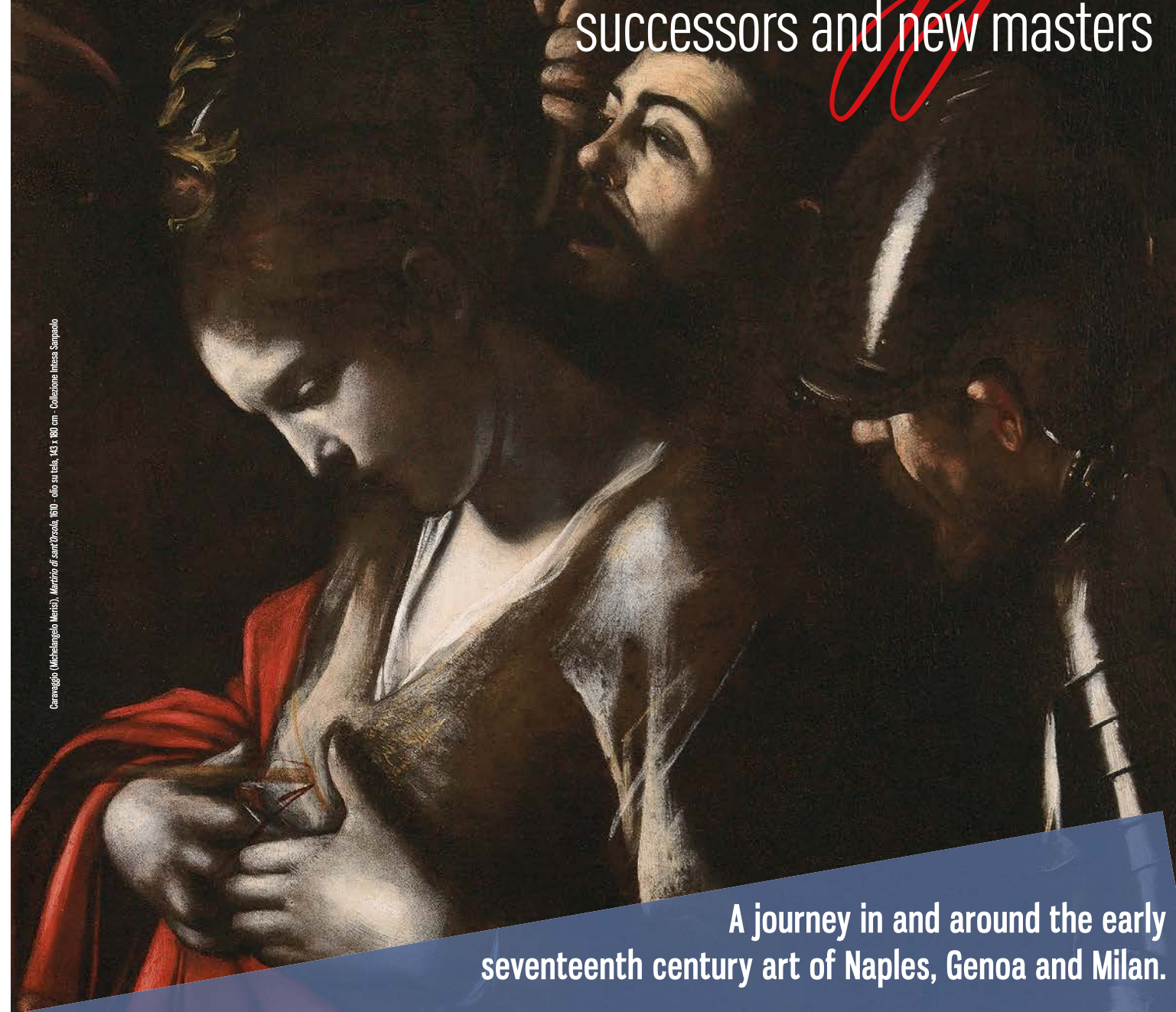
