» FOCUS

Top Breweries

As everyone knows October is the month dedicated to the best wines and their sparkling counterparts. In Milan, for example, an ultra-glam, not-to-be-missed event is the "Vendemmia di Montenapoleone" (from 7 to 13 October). In addition to wine, Milan also offers a number of great addresses for beer lovers thanks to a number of fab drinking dens where you can taste the best hops.

Brewery **Isola della Birra** is an unassuming pub furnished in typically rustic style, a spartan though welcoming venue where you can choose from among a wide range of Italian and foreign beverages, with something new always on offer. Simple dishes – which, on Sunday are substituted with a mouth watering sushi menu from the nearby Gen Kay Sushi restaurant – guarantee an informal though even more flavour-filled evening (via Medardo Rosso 18, www.isoladellabirra.com).

Reputed throughout the world, the multi-award winning **Birrificio di Lambrate** continues to evolve

while remaining true to tradition. The place is a mix between a typical British pub and a pirate ship displaying photographs, beer mugs and period memorabilia, this Brewpub is a great place to spend pleasant themed evenings, savour refined cuisine and, above all, feel like a special guest as you ask for a refill of your own personalized beer mug (via Adelchi 5 – via Golgi 60, www.birrificio lambrate.com).

Located on the Naviglio Pavese, **La Fontanella** is the ideal place to down a beer in the company of friends, an unconventional tavern where beer and the extravagant beer mugs in which it is served



take centre stage: from the crazy-shaped "octopus", a fish bowl with tentacles which act as pumps for the alcohol so that people can serve themselves simultaneously, to eight different types of mugs shaped like tulips, tankards and many others besides. And for those who are interested, the venue also offers a number of board games to further liven up the atmosphere (Alzaia Naviglio Pavese, 6).

Al Coccio is a cozy beer pub featuring a contemporary take on the typical stone and rock atmosphere of old-world taverns. The ambience is warmed by the soothing notes of jazz and soft rock and also offers a secluded reading area. At Al Coccio you can allow yourselves to be tempted by six varieties of either Italian or foreign draught beer served in terracotta "cocci" or crocks (Alzaia Naviglio Pavese, 2).

Woodstock: a name inspired by the famous 1969 festival just like this pub which was founded during the same era on the Naviglio Grande, a compulsory stopover for real beer connoisseurs. Situated in front of the old church of S. Cristoforo, an array of coloured stools and small sideboards transformed into tables are scattered along the pavement, thus immediately conveying the atmosphere of a real, old-world pub. Carries more than 600 specialties from all over the world and 14 variations of beer tapped directly from the cask (Via Ludovico il Moro 3, www.woodstock-milano.com).

Music, mega screens, wooden stools and rustically adorned tables fill the rooms of this crowded, open brickwork tavern on two floors. **Carlsberg Ol** is a place where you can spend a

pleasant, entertaining evening enhanced by good food and a garden overlooking the "Chiusa di Leonardo" (the lock designed by Leonardo da Vinci), one of the most evocative spaces of the pub (Bastioni di Porta Nuova 9, www.carlsbergol.it).

A charming shop in the Corso Buenos Aires area, Milan's commercial artery, furnished in Bavarian style: to appreciate **A Tutta Birra** you don't have to be a connoisseur but simply someone with a passion for beer. It offers a wide range of goodies, from the drink itself to everything related to the universe of malt. A store rich in ideas where the owner will be delighted to introduce you to unusual products and more than 500 types of international ales (Via Lazzaro Palazzi 15, www.atuttabirra.com).

Baladin in the Heart of Brera

Baladin, a new reference point for discerning beer drinkers, is located at number 56 via Solferino. Already a landmark venue in other Italian cities, Baladin recently opened its doors in the heart of Brera and, true to the tradition of its other eponymous brewpubs, it offers a great vintage atmosphere, house draft beers, a rotating selection of microbreweries and simple menus based on locally sourced products. For example, its hamburgers are made from "Slow Food" Piedmontese beef and its chips are only prepared when your order is taken. www.baladin.it

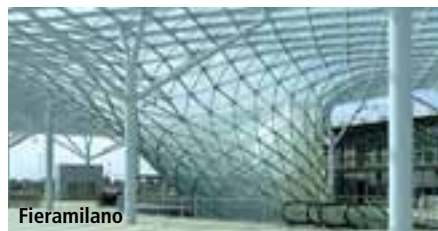

—The Last Supper by Leonardo da Vinci

One of the most famous attractions in the world, "L'Ultima Cena" or "Cenacolo" by **Leonardo da Vinci** is a large 15th century mural painting representing the scene of the last supper of Jesus narrated in the Gospel. It can be found in the church of Santa Maria delle Grazie.

—Duomo, the symbol of Milan

Among one of the most important (and majestic) Gothic buildings in the world, the **Duomo**, constructed on and off over a period of 450 years (begun 1386) is the symbol of Milan. To experience it at its most majestic you must ascend to the roof (either by elevator or by steps) where you will be surrounded by an outburst of pinnacles, turrets and marble statuary and, naturally, the city's famed golden Madonnina. The cathedral is open daily 8.30am-6.45pm. Admission free. www.duomomilano.it

—"Il Castello"

The ancient seat of the ruling Visconti, the **Castello Sforzesco** was later rebuilt by Francesco Sforza and is now simply known by the Milanese as "Il Castello". Demolished and reconstructed several times from 1300 onwards, it has served as the backdrop for numerous historic events. Today, it houses a number of interesting museums and libraries. Its park is a favourite with old and young alike. Open daily 7am-6pm. Free admission.

—Galleria, the "living room" of the Milanese

Sometimes known as "the living-room of the Milanese", **Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II** with its elegant, four-storey arcade, housing luxury cafés and famous designer shops, is covered by a glass barrel vault and a beautiful glass cupola and measures 196 metres in length. Tradition has it that placing your right heel on the bull, depicted in the mosaic on the floor, and then spinning around inside it, will bring good luck.

—The Opera house

The world's premier opera house, built at the behest of Empress Maria Teresa of Austria and designed by Piermarini, the **Teatro alla Scala** was inaugurated in 1778 with an opera by Antonio Salieri. www.teatroallascala.org

—Ambrosiana, all about Leonardo

The **Ambrosiana picture gallery** contains several exquisite works of art from the 15th through 17th centuries and includes "The musician", attributed to Leonardo, Raphael's cartoon for the "School of Athens" fresco and Caravaggio's "Basket of fruit".

The **Ambrosiana library** will be exhibiting Leonardo's entire **Codex Atlanticus** until 2015, 44 or 45 pages at a time for three months at a stretch.

—Science and technology

The **Museo Nazionale della Scienza e della Tecnologia Leonardo da Vinci** is one of the most important museums of science and technology in the world. Its collections, featuring cars, aircraft, ships, scooters, trains, reconstructions of ancient workshops for metalworking, explore the relationship between men and machines starting from Leonardo da Vinci. —Milan's Street of Art

Following the opening of "Cantiere del '900", a new section of the Gallerie di Piazza Scala, Milan has been enriched by a new art circuit featuring the city's three main museum hubs: the **Pinacoteca di Brera**, the **Gallerie d'Italia** in piazza della Scala and the civic complex consisting of **Palazzo Reale** and the **Museo del Novecento**. An itinerary extending over 900 metres, that can be crossed on foot in just 15 minutes, from via Brera to piazzetta Reale, cutting through piazza Scala and the Galleria, which hosts an extraordinary part of our country's art history.

Milan is the home of the **Aperitivo** and it is most definitely a ritual which no Milanese is prepared to forego. Favourite beverages consumed during this beloved tradition include the city's renowned Martini, Prosecco or Campari, accompanied by an all-you-can-eat buffet. A myriad of venues, ranging from the smallest bars to larger, uber-chic locations situated in the heart of the city, organize this event. There are 3 types of venues: **design bars** (Just Cavalli, Armani, Dolce&Gabbana Gold, Il Gattopardo Café), **traditional bars** (the places that have written Milan's history including Bar Zucca and Caffè Biffi in Galleria Vittorio Emanuele, Cova in via Montenapoleone and Bar Magenta for a younger crowd); and, the latest trend, all **luxury hotel bars**. There are three main areas dedicated

to nighttime entertainment featuring a concentration of venues (see Map at pages 62-63):
• **Navigli District**: an area characterized by places offering live music, patronized by artists, models, musicians and university students. Must-try options are its boat bars and the area's old *osterie* where you can sample an array of wines, cold cuts and typical cheeses.
• **Brera District**: an historic area boasting a warren of characteristic venues offering live music and, believe it or not, fortune-tellers who are happy to predict your future for a small fee...
• **Garibaldi District & Corso Como**: this is Milan's most fashionable area by night, where, not only will you find a bevy of pizzerie, restaurants, pubs and discotheques, but also possibly chance upon showbiz celebs and sports heroes.

The most exclusive Clubs. First and foremost, **Armani Privé** in the Montenapoleone area, where you can club 'til dawn amidst VIPs, business magnates and Milanese jet-setters. And, then again, **Just Cavalli Restaurant & Club**, set against the backdrop of Parco Sempione, recently elected "The Best Club in The World" in Monte Carlo, featuring ultra-exclusive parties and international stars hailing from all parts of the globe. Also worth a visit is the highly unusual **Gattopardo Club**, a deconsecrated church often used for film shoots. Another of my favourites is the recently opened, ultra-trendy **Club Byblos** which is already becoming a cult venue. And, finally landmark club, **Hollywood** (Corso Como), which stays open until the wee hours of the morning.

DUOMO CATHEDRAL—Among one of the most important (and majestic) Gothic buildings in the world, the church, constructed on and off over a period of 450 years (begun 1386) is the symbol of Milan. Built in the shape of a Latin cross, the cathedral is divided by soaring pillars into five naves, the largest of which measures 45 metres in height. It has 135 spires and its inside columns measure 3 and a half metres in diameter. To experience the Duomo at its most majestic you must ascend to the roof (either by elevator or by steps) where you will be surrounded by an outburst of pinnacles, turrets and marble statuary and, naturally, the city’s famed golden Madonna. The Ambrosiana will be exhibiting Leonardo’s entire “Codice Atlantico” (Atlantic Codex) until 2015, 44 or 45 pages at a time for three months at a stretch – the longest the International archival norms will allow such documents to be exposed to light. The San Siro Stadium



Named after the famous Milanese footballer Giuseppe Meazza, the **Giuseppe Meazza Stadium** (San Siro) is the largest stadium in Italy and the third in Europe. All seats are covered in this three-tiered structure which has a capacity of 79,341 and is the home stadium of two of the three most successful Italian Football League clubs: **A.C. Milan** and **F.C. Internazionale (Inter)**. It also has a **gift shop** (T: 02 4046430) and a museum (T: 02 4042432) displaying all kinds of historic items from both Milan’s and Inter’s past: old jerseys, photos, boots, tickets and a fabulous trophy case. However, even better than the **museum** is the guided stadium tour which gives you a chance to sit in VIP seats and visit each of the home teams’ locker rooms. 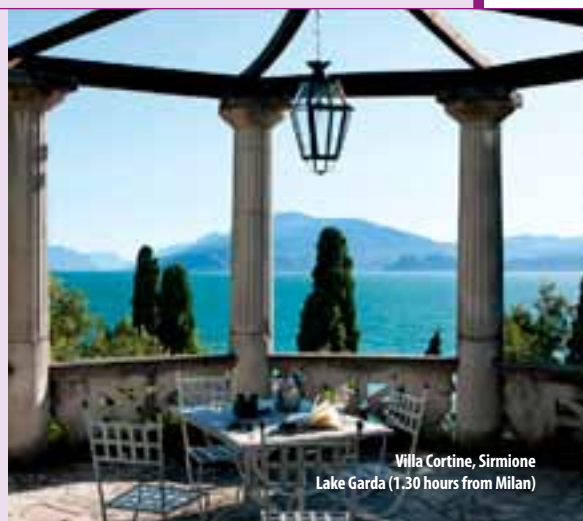
